The Old Church Theater is teaming up with Joe Callahan and Tim Campbell to produce "Live is Where it Lives" a radio show that will be recorded in the Roy Bonisteel Studio in front of a studio audience. The pilot is scheduled for Friday October 16<sup>th</sup> at 8 pm.

The recorded show will be broadcast on 91X, Loyalist College Radio (91.3FM) in the new year as the first in a series of performances by artists from an eclectic range of musical styles

Callahan and Campbell are no strangers to radio and live music production. For four years in the mid 90's they produced Handmade Music with a similar approach to what they will be doing with "Live is Where it Lives".

"I think the key feature of "Live is Where it Lives" is that every show will be recorded with a live audience which gives performers that added energy and immediate feedback that is often missing with studio recordings," said Callahan. "And the Old Church Theatre is a great place for folks to go for an evening's entertainment."

Live is Where it Lives will be one of a number of a number of specialty programs that 91x features as part of its weekend schedule.

"91X is extremely happy to be part of this project and provide a broadcast outlet for these performances. We worked with Joe and Tim in the Handmade Music series and are delighted this type of live approach will be returning," says Station Manager Greg Schatzmann.

The Old Church Theatre, located at 940 Bonisteel Road in Quinte West has been a busy live music venue over the past year with performances by nationally known artists Valdy and Ron Hynes, as well as numerous musicians from the greater Quinte area.

"We're looking forward to this new venture and bringing this kind of live performance to our venue," says the Old Church Theatre's Lesley Bonisteel. "Radio

is where my dad started his broadcast career in the Quinte region and it's great to be recording a new radio show here at the Roy Bonisteel Studio".
