You will then travel to Cusco, to see how Andean and Spanish cultures co-existed, before you board a bus to Puno, passing through scenic highlands and traditional Andean villages. Finally, prepare for a boat ride on Lake Titicaca, the highest navigable lake in the world, and catch a return flight to Lima, before your small-group tour of Peru comes to an end!

TOUR ITINERARY:

DAY 01: USA/CANADA - LIMA

Make your own way to your chosen airport for your international flight to Lima. Enjoy in-flight services and meals.
Overnight onboard flight

DAY 02: LIMA - CUSCO (BY FLIGHT) - URUBAMBA (SACRED VALLEY) (ARRIVAL)

Welcome to Peru! Upon arrival at the Lima International Airport, you will connect to your domestic flight to Cusco, a short yet spectacular flight over the snow-capped Andes Mountains. Reach Cusco, the oldest inhabited city in the hemisphere, with an elevation of 11,440 feet. Upon arrival, you will be met and transferred to your hotel in Urubamba in the Sacred Valley.
Overnight in Urubamba

DAY 03: SACRED VALLEY (B/-/-)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. Today you will have a full day at leisure to explore the valley on your own or take an optional tour.
Overnight in Urubamba

Optional: Full Day Excursion to the Pisac Indian Market and Ollantaytambo Fortress Including Lunch at the Urubamba River: CAD 180 per person

Drive through the fertile countryside of the Urubamba Valley to the colonial village of Pisac, where you may explore the bustling Indian Market and purchase many types of Peruvian handicrafts. From there you will visit Ollantaytambo, an ancient Incan fort. Lunch will be served at a beautiful country estate on the banks of the Urubamba River.



DAY 04: SACRED VALLEY - MACHU PICCHU - CUSCO (B/-/-)

In the morning you will travel on the Expedition train through the Sacred Valley to **Agua Calientes**, where you will board a shuttle up to Machu Picchu — the "Lost City of the Incas". Perched 8,200 feet above the valley, the city of Machu Picchu was hidden by mountains and semi-tropical jungles for 400 years until it was discovered by Hiram Bingham in 1911. A knowledgeable tour guide will share the history of this magical place with you. In the afternoon you will take the train back to Ollantaytambo Rail Station, where you will be met and transferred to your hotel in Cusco.

DAY 05: CUSCO (B/-/-)

After breakfast, you will head on a tour of Cusco, the oldest continuously inhabited city in the western hemisphere, and its nearby ruins. You will get the opportunity to see how the Andean and Spanish cultures co-existed and influenced the city. The tour will begin at **the Santo Domingo Convent**, built on the site of Koricancha, a significant Inca palace and a center of worship to the Sun God. You will continue your tour to discover **the Main Square, the site of the Cathedral, and La Compañía Church**. Later, visit the imposing **Sacsayhuaman Fortress**, a perfect example of the military Incan architecture in the area. Finally, the tour will take you to the archaeological sites of Qenko, Puca-Pucara, and Tambomachay, situated northeast of the city.
Overnight in Cusco

DAY 06: CUSCO - PUNO (B/L/-)

Today you will head on one of the most extraordinary overland trips in South America. Prepare for a **bus ride from Cusco to Puno** as you pass through the striking highlands and the scenic Andean villages. There will be an en-route stop in **Andahuaylillas**, a beautiful town where the church was founded in 1580. This is the perfect showcase of colonial art in Peru — sometimes referred to as "the Sistine Chapel of the Americas" due to its rich interior. You will also stop at **Raqchi** to see the remains of the temple of Viracocha, considered by historians to be a particularly significant Inca construction, and at La Raya, the highest pass on the route. Along with the breathtaking views of the countryside, you will discover llamas, alpacas, and vicunas roaming the wild. The last stop before Puno will be in **Pucara**, a historic ceremonial site where evidence of a pre-Inca civilization remains. You will arrive at your hotel in Puno later in the afternoon/evening.

DAY 07: UROS AND TAQUILE ISLANDS (LAKE TITICACA) (B/-/-)

Head on an exhilarating boat excursion on **Lake Titicaca** - the highest navigable lake in the world. See the magnificent floating Uros Islands and Taquile Island. The floating islands of the Uros developed from totora reeds tied together and are a must-see for any traveler! The Uros people consider themselves to be the Lords of the Lake. They hunt wild birds and maintain traditional fishing methods. Taquile is a very important site, known for its archaeological remains, sacred sites, and ceremonial festivals. The island is characterized by its friendly inhabitants, who maintain the customs and traditional clothing of their ancestors. Many fine, woollen hand-made goods can be found on sale here. You will return to Puno later in the day.

Overnight in Puno

DAY 08: PUNO - LIMA (BY FLIGHT) (B/-/-)

Today you will be transferred to the Juliaca Airport for your flight back to Lima. Upon arrival, you will be met by your local guide and transferred to your hotel. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure or perhaps take an optional tour to explore the capital city of Peru.

Overnight in Lima

Optional: Experience Lima: An Evening at the Larco Museum with Dinner CAD 175 per person

After hotel pick up in Lima, travel to the site of the Larco Museum in an air-conditioned minivan, accompanied by a knowledgeable guide. Enter the museum and begin your enriching exploration of the exhibitions; see over 50,000 ancient Peruvian pots; admire glittering jewelry and intricate masks; marvel at the accurate detail of Moche portrait vessels, ceramic sculptures resembling human faces; and discover ceramics created by ancient Inca, Nazca, and Chancay cultures. After gaining heightened historical insight, take a seat in the elegant dining room to begin your epicurean experience. Enjoy the ambient atmospheric and beautifully sculpted gardens as you sip a freshly mixed pisco sour and converse with your companion. Pleasure your palate with regional specialties like lomo saltado, tender strips of beef cooked with vegetables and spices, accompanied by creamy causa limena, a mashed potato dish flavored with chili and lime. Digest your excellent experience during the relaxing ride back to your Lima hotel.

DAY 09: LIMA (B/-/-)

Today you will head on a half-day tour to explore the modern and colonial parts of Lima, the "City of Kings". Start your tour in the districts of **Miraflores and San Isidro**. En route, you will see a **Huaca** or sacred pre-Inca site. There will be a stop at the Parque del Amor (Lovers Park) in

Miraflores to see the breathtaking view of the Pacific Ocean. Discover the Historic Centre based on the **Main Square, where the Presidential Palace, the Archbishop's Palace, the Municipality of Lima, and the Cathedral are located**, and head on a visit to one of the largest colonial-era convents. After your tour, you will have free time to explore the city at your own pace.



Optional: Dinner at Huaca Pucllana Restaurant (private transfers and escort): CAD 199 per person

The Huaca Pucllana Restaurant is situated within the ancient ruins of Huaca Pucllana, an archaeological site constructed 1500 years ago. Overlooking the illuminated ruins at Huaca Pucllana, this restaurant serves a wide range of contemporary Peruvian dishes. Huaca Pucllana offers a mouth-watering selection of Peruvian Criollo cuisine, cleverly put together by the head chef Marilú Madueño (Cordon Blue Paris), using her skills to mix local ingredients and flavors with modern cooking techniques. The menu includes ceviches, soups, pasta, meats, and traditional Peruvian dishes such as Creole-style Chupe

Today, you will be transferred to Lima International Airport for your flight home.
